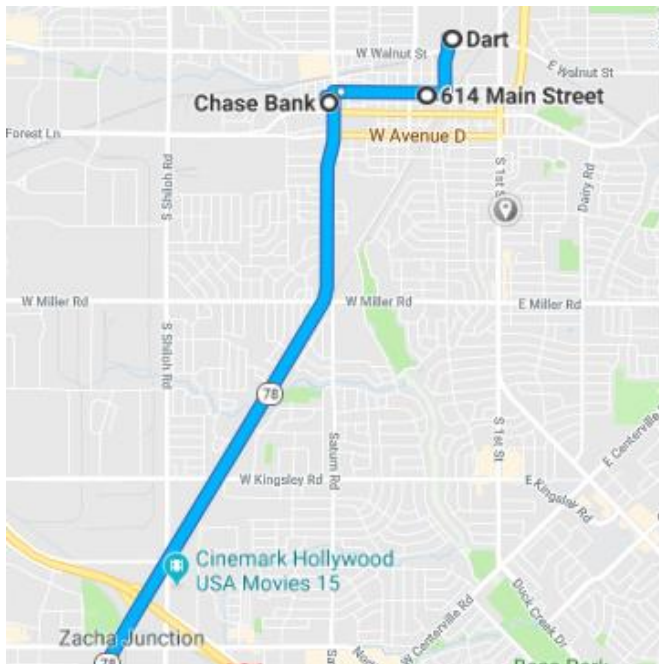


START POINT

Dos Banderas, 614 Main St, Garland, TX 75043

Garland is located northeast of Dallas. Take LBJ (635) to the Garland Road exit, then north on Garland Road to Main Street then right (east) on Main St to Dos Banderas on the right just before the downtown square. Parking is available on the town square and adjacent streets. You may also take the DART BLUE line to the Downtown Garland stop at Walnut and 5th Street. After exiting DART, walk to 5th St, left on 5th 3 blocks to Main St, right on Main 1.5 blocks to start point.

This is a non-competitive walk. Everyone is welcome. You may walk for free if you do not wish IVV credit. An adult must accompany children under 12 years of age at all times. All persons must register, sign a waiver of liability, and carry a start card and return this start card to the finish upon completion of the walk.

Registration is at the Start Point on the day of the walk.

WALK DESCRIPTION

Garland, with a population of over 220,000, is the 12th largest city in the state, and yet, it maintains its small town charm with a quaint downtown plaza. Garland was incorporated as a town in 1891 after a post office was authorized to serve the Duck Creek and Embree settlements and was named for U. S. Attorney General A. H. Garland. The walk passes local businesses (Generator Coffee Shop, Plaza Theater, the Roach Feed & Seed Store, Richland College Garland Campus, Civic Center) and many historic churches and markers.

The walk will be on city sidewalks and some grass and is rated 1A and is suitable for strollers, however wheelchairs may have some difficulty.
