Hagerman National Wildlife Refuge is known for migratory birds by the thousands that use the refuge for winter quarters or to refuel for their long journey. As you drive to the Meadow Pond trailhead, look for Canada, snow, white-fronted, and Ross' geese along with pintail, mallard, gadwall and other ducks. At times, as many as 10,000 geese can be seen in one field.

The Meadow Pond Trail is out and back on an old railway bed. The Trail features two ponds, Mineral Creek, bottomland hardwoods, and meadows that attract a variety of wildlife. As you walk keep an eye out for white-tailed deer, bobcats, river otters, turtles, fox squirrels and perhaps coyotes.

This walk is open to the public. Everyone is welcome. Children under 12 must be accompanied by and adult.

All participants sign a waiver of liability and carry a start card that is returned to the finish table at Dunford Recreation Center.
